# Get started - Smartphones!

## I. Installation

There are two ways of installing Wayfinder Navigator™:

### Download from the Internet browser in your phone

1. Go to <http://na.getwf.com> from the Internet browser in your mobile phone.
2. Accept connecting to the Internet. If you cannot connect to the Internet, check your access points in the settings of your phone or contact your network service provider and ask for an Internet connection\*.
3. Open the link “**Click here**” to start downloading Wayfinder Navigator™.
4. Answer **Yes** to the questions that you are asked before the installation begins.
5. If there is a memory card/stick in your phone, you need to decide if you want to save the software in the internal memory or on the memory card/stick.
6. When installation is complete, the Wayfinder application will automatically start up and you will be asked to activate the service. (If Wayfinder does not start automatically, click on the Wayfinder icon in the main menu.)

### Download from a computer

**Alternatively** you can download the Wayfinder Navigator™ software and transfer it to your phone via Bluetooth/Infrared/USB-cable. Please visit <http://na.getwayfinder.com> and select **Install Wayfinder** under **New Customer** for more details.

*\*3G-subscribers connect via 3G and usually have an Internet Access Point pre-configured.*

## II. Activation

Now it is time to connect to the Wayfinder server via the Internet - **GPRS Internet** (not WAP) or **3G**. If you do not have an GPRS Internet subscription, please contact your network service provider.

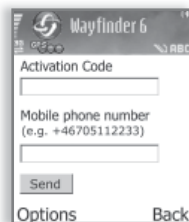
1. When Wayfinder starts, read and accept the User Terms.

2. Allow connection with the Internet by pressing **Yes**.

We recommend you to choose **Automatic Search** for an Internet Access Point. Accept the working Internet Access Point that is found. If you do not have an Internet Access Point, a message with the text "No Internet access point available" will be shown.

*If your mobile phone does not automatically detect an Internet Access Point, please contact your network service provider or visit the support area on the webpage of your phone manufacturer\**

3. A view with three alternatives is shown. Highlight **Activate** and press the joystick or use the stylus. Enter your **activation code**. Thereafter, enter your **phone number** in the international format (eg. 650-123-4567 becomes +16501234567).

4. Select **Send**.

5. Complete your activation by allowing Wayfinder Navigator™ to send an activation SMS to the Wayfinder server. Please note that you will not receive a reply.

6. The main menu of Wayfinder will be displayed.

## Get started - Java based phones!

The following instructions on only concern Java based phones manufactured by Sony Ericsson, Nokia or Motorola (e.g. Sony Ericsson W300, Nokia 6280, Motorola RAZR V3x).

### Installation and activation

Please be aware that the installation process may differ between phone models.


1. Please read the instructions that came with your GPS receiver. Charge the GPS receiver before you turn it on. Make sure that it has a clear view of the sky; e.g. put it next to a window if you are inside a building or on the dashboard of your car.
2. Go to <http://na.getwf.com> from the Internet browser in your mobile phone.
3. Accept connecting to the Internet.

*If you cannot connect to the internet, check your access points in the settings of your phone. For Sony Ericsson phones: Go to **Menu > Settings**, scroll to the **Connectivity** tab and choose **Internet Settings > Internet profiles**. Here you should mark the correct access point. (If you are not sure which one is the correct one you can configure an access point at <http://na.getwayfinder.com>). Then go to **Menu > Settings**, scroll to the **Connectivity** tab and choose **Settings for Java**. Here the same access point as in Internet Settings should be marked.*

*If you then still can't connect to the Internet please contact your network operator and ask for GPRS-internet or 3G.*

4. Click on the link "**Click here**" to download the software and then select Games or Programs to save the application on the phone.
5. Select **Start now** and allow an Internet connection. Answer **Yes** to the questions that you are asked before the installation begins.

- When the installation is complete the Wayfinder application appears and you will be asked to enter your **activation code**. Thereafter, enter your **phone number** in the international format (eg. 650-123-4567 becomes +16501234567).

- Select **Send**.
- The mobile phone searches for available Bluetooth units. Select your Bluetooth GPS receiver. Bluetooth GPS receivers that are found should be marked with an asterisk\*. Accept connection with your Bluetooth GPS receiver.
- The main menu of Wayfinder will be displayed.
- When the GPS receiver has pinpointed your position, the quality of your GPS position  will be shown in the map view of your mobile phone. **X** means that there is no GPS data. Usually it takes about 30 seconds for the GPS receiver to find your position when turned on. However, the first time it could take up to 20 minutes.

## Get started - BlackBerry!


The following instructions only concern **BlackBerry** phones.

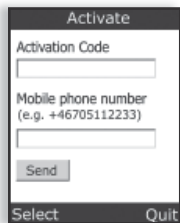
Please be aware that the installation process may differ between phone models.

1. Please read the instructions that came with your GPS receiver. Charge the GPS receiver before you turn it on. Make sure that it has a clear view of the sky; e.g. put it next to a window if you are inside a building or on the dashboard of your car.
2. Pair your phone with your GPS receiver. For more information on pairing your phone, please visit our online manual at **[www.MyWayfinder.com/manual](http://www.MyWayfinder.com/manual)**.

*Sometimes a PIN code is required when pairing your phone. Most devices use 0000. If this does not work, please check with your supplier to find out the correct PIN code.*

3. Verify that you have Internet Access:
  - a) Look for an icon in the main menu named "Internet Browser". If this is present, please go directly to step 4.
  - b) Go into **Settings -> Advanced Options -> Service Book**. If this view is empty, please contact your network service provider to have service entries\* sent to your handheld. Once you have the service entries, please begin from **a)**.
  - c) If your BlackBerry is connected to an Enterprise Server, please check with your server administrator to see if you can access the Internet with applications such as Wayfinder.
  - d) If the steps above do not work, please contact your network service provider and ask for Internet Access Point settings that allow unmodified HTTP traffic to pass through on port 80 or 12211. Enter the details in **Settings > Advanced Options > TCP** (does not apply to BlackBerry 8707).

- Go to **<http://na.getwf.com>** from the Internet browser in your mobile phone.
- Click on the link **Click here** and select **Download** to download the software.
- If asked to reboot your phone, please accept. When the phone is rebooted, open the application by clicking on the Wayfinder icon in the program menu.
- When the installation is complete, select **Run** to start the Wayfinder application. You will now be asked to enter your **activation code**. Thereafter, enter your **phone number** in the international format (eg. 650-123-4567 becomes +16501234567).
- Press **Send**.
- You will now be asked if you want to set up your GPS. Select **Yes** and select your GPS from the list with paired GPS devices that are shown.
- The main menu of Wayfinder will be displayed.
- When the GPS receiver has pinpointed your position, the quality of your GPS position  will be shown in the map view of your mobile phone. **X** means that there is no GPS data. Usually it takes about 30 seconds for the GPS receiver to find your position when turned on. Please note that the first time you do this, it could take up to 20 minutes.
